AARP Community Challenge	Projects need to deliver on one or all of the following drivers for change: Improve a community's built environment to benefit people of all ages and ability levels and connect to the social environment; Expand opportunities for all residents, such as through jobs, volunteerism, educational opportunities and training; Drive community engagement and interaction across diverse community residents via, for instance, efforts in the domains of culture and art, local communications, public spaces and placemaking, sports, education, well-being, healthy living, etc.	15–Jul–1 <i>7</i>
Mediacom Arts and Culture Grants	Provides funding annually to Dubuque arts and "non-arts organizations" to support a distinct aspect of the organization's arts activities, such as a one-time event, a single production, an exhibition, an educational seminar, or series of related arts activities, such as art classes or training sessions.	31–Jul–1 <i>7</i>
Eastern Iowa Regional Housing Corporation	The mission of the EIRHC Housing Trust Fund is to assist in the provision of providing decent, safe and affordable housing, as well as providing access to the resources for creating housing opportunities to the families served in eastern Iowa. The emphasis is to provide economic assistance to benefit the -moderate, very low, and extremely low-income residents of Dubuque, Delaware, Jackson, Cedar and Clinton Counties for a variety of housing needs.	1-Aug-17

<u>Dyersville Area Community</u> <u>Foundation</u>	The Dyersville Area Community Foundation makes grants to nonprofits with a 501 C (3) status that are located in the communities of Dyersville, Earlville, Farley, Luxemburg, New Vienna, Petersburg, and Worthington. Applications are available in June and due in August. Grants are awarded in September.	15-Aug-17
Anamosa Community Foundation	Organizations applying for grant funding must be applying for a project which is specifically for Anamosa. The amount of funds available this year is \$5,000.	31-Aug-17
Alliant Energy Foundation – Community Grant	All projects must fit into one of our three focus areas. Helping Families, Education, Environment. Our grant- making process is highly competitive. Grants from the Foundation typically range from \$500 to \$5,000, with an average grant of \$2,500. In 2016, the Foundation awarded 266 grants totaling more than \$656,000.	1-Sep-17
