Call to Order

The Wednesday, September 3rd, 2025, Regional Transit Authority (RTA) Board meeting was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Vice Chair Flagel.

Action on the Agenda for the Wednesday, September 3, 2025, RTA Board Meeting

Ravada requested a revision of the agenda, deleting item 5 as financials were not ready for the meeting and adding item 9 to discuss the RTAP Community Rides Grant. Motion by Steines, second by Wheeler to approve the revised agenda for the September 3rd, 2025, RTA Board Meeting.

Action on approving the minutes and file the Secretarial notes from the May 7, 2025, RTA Board Meeting

Motion by Pothoff, second by Helmrichs, to approve the minutes and file the Secretarial Notes from the August 6, 2025, RTA Board Meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Review and Approve Invoices and Bills
