<a href="#">Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)</a>	The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) provides grants to states, local governments, and Native American tribes for long-term hazard mitigation projects after a major disaster declaration. The purpose of the program is to reduce the loss of life and property in future disasters by funding mitigation measures during the recovery phase of a natural disaster. States receive HMGP funding when a Presidential Disaster Declaration has been made.	DR-4732 application is OPEN. Deadline: June 30, 2024
<a href="#">Community Foundation of Greater Dubuque Community Impact Grants</a>	Community Impact Grants aim to support capacity building efforts at nonprofits in the CFGD service area.	Available May 30, due by June 30
<a href="#">Iowa Community Cultural Grant</a>	Iowa Community Cultural Grants enhance Iowa communities through the development of festivals, music, drama, cultural programs and tourism projects that provide jobs for Iowans while promoting Iowa's cultural, ethnic and historical heritages.	July 1st
<a href="#">State Recreational Trails Program (SRT)</a>	Funding to establish recreational trails for the use, enjoyment and participation of the public.	July 1st

<p><a href="#">CDBG Water/Sewer Fund</a></p>	<p>The program is funded through the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The goal of this program is to provide economic opportunities for people, especially those of low- and moderate income. Funds awarded through this annual competitive program assist cities and counties with projects such as sanitary sewer system improvements, water system improvements, water and wastewater treatment facility projects, storm sewer projects related to sanitary sewer system improvements and rural water connections.</p>	<p>July 1st</p>
<p><a href="#">Havlife Tri-States Grants</a></p>	<p>HAVlife™ grants to other 501(c)3 organizations to support youth in the community, specifically, supporting youth ages 10 to 15 in activities related to arts, music and athletics.</p>	<p>July</p>
<p><a href="#">National Endowment for the Arts - Grants for Arts Projects</a></p>	<p>These grants support arts projects that use the arts to unite and heal in response to current events; celebrate our creativity and cultural heritage; invite mutual respect for differing beliefs and values; and enrich humanity.</p>	<p>July 11th</p>
<p><a href="#">National Endowment for the Arts - Our Town</a></p>	<p>Our Town is our creative placemaking grants program, using arts, culture, and design to strengthen communities and advance local priorities such as health, community development, environment/climate, and public safety, among other community issues and aspirations.</p>	<p>August 1st</p>
<p><a href="#">Clinton County Community Development Association</a></p>	<p>Our purpose is to provide financial assistance through our grant programs for local organizations and charities that work to improve the overall vitality and quality of life in our county, through their educational, social, cultural, and environmental programs and initiatives.</p>	<p>August 14th</p>
<p><a href="#">Resource Enhancement &amp; Protection (REAP) - City Parks &amp; Open Spaces</a></p>	<p>100 % funding of parkland expansion and multi-purpose outdoor-related recreation development.</p>	<p>August 15th</p>
<p><a href="#">Resource Enhancement &amp; Protection (REAP) - DNR Open Spaces Protection: Acquisition &amp; Development</a></p>	<p>Cost-share program that allows private conservation organizations and the DNR to jointly acquire property to help provide outdoor recreation opportunities and protect critical habitats.</p>	<p>August 15th</p>
<p><a href="#">Traffic Safety Improvement Program</a></p>	<p>Funds to cities and counties for roadway safety improvements, traffic control devices, studies, and outreach.</p>	<p>August 15th</p>

<a href="#">Dyersville Area Community Foundation</a>	The mission of the Dyersville Area Community Foundation is to connect area community needs with charitable donors.	Available July 15, due August 31
<a href="#">Theisen's More for Your Community</a>	The Theisen's More for Your Community Program makes grants to agencies to jumpstart and/or sustain projects which most effectively and directly serve the basic needs of families and children, including food, shelter, education, safety and health.	August 31st
<a href="#">Wahlert Foundation</a>	Embracing Christian values and guided by compassion for those less fortunate, the Wahlert Foundation continues the legacy of the Wahlert family by acting as a steward of the Foundation's assets for the betterment of life in the Dubuque, Iowa, community by giving primarily in the areas of education, food, shelter, human services, and a limited funding of the arts.	Applications accepted between June 1 and Sept 1
<a href="#">Andersen Corporate Foundation</a>	The mission of the Andersen Corporate Foundation is to improve lives and strengthen communities where Andersen employees live and work. It has donated more than \$60 million while supporting nonprofit organizations in housing, healthcare, hunger relief and education.	Application open August 1 - 31
<a href="#">Redevelopment Tax Credits Brownfield/Grayfield Sites</a>	This program assists with redevelopment aimed at improving Iowa's economy while reducing environmental hazards.	Accepted annually during the months of July and August with a September 1 deadline
<a href="#">Trust for Civic Life</a>	The Trust for Civic Life, a collaborative that launched in February, funds small town entrepreneurs, cultural centers, hobby groups, and public venues to create avenues for community participation.	A second round of nominations opens in August for a grant cycle focused on individual efforts and civic innovation
