Grant/Loan Program	Program Purpose	Due Date
<a href="#">CDBG-Water/Sewage Fund</a>	Funds awarded through this annual competitive program assist cities and counties with projects such as sanitary sewer system improvements, water system improvements, water and wastewater treatment facility projects, storm sewer projects related to sanitary sewer system improvements and rural water connections. The program is funded through the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The goal of this program is to provide economic opportunities for people, especially those of low- and moderate income.	1-Oct-20
<a href="#">Community Foundation of Jackson County</a>	Grants awarded are in the priority areas of community development, diversity, education, our environment, health and human services, children, youth, families and senior citizens, arts and culture including historic preservation, and wellness projects.	1-Oct-20
<a href="#">Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)</a>	Funding for surface transportation alternatives projects and initiatives that are statewide or multiregional in nature and relate to transportation.	1-Oct-20
<a href="#">Recreational Trails Program (Federal)</a>	Funding to provide and maintain motorized and non-motorized recreational trails and trail-related projects.	1-Oct-20

<a href="#">National Trust for Historic Preservation</a>	<p>Grants from National Trust Preservation Funds (NTPF) are intended to encourage preservation at the local level by providing seed money for preservation projects. These grants help stimulate public discussion, enable local groups to gain the technical expertise needed for particular projects, introduce the public to preservation concepts and techniques, and encourage financial participation by the private sector.</p>	<p>1-Oct-20</p>
<a href="#">Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program (ICAAP)</a>	<p>Funding for highway/street, transit, bicycle/pedestrian or freight projects or programs which help maintain Iowa's clean air quality by reducing transportation-related emissions. Eligible highway/street projects must be on the federal-aid system.</p>	<p>1-Oct-20</p>
<a href="#">Jones County Community Foundation</a>	<p>Jones County Community Foundation grants to projects benefiting persons residing in Jones County, Iowa. Our priorities include economic well-being, quality of life, educational opportunities, tourism and recreation, and Jones County heritage preservation.</p>	<p>15-Oct-20</p>
<a href="#">Georgia-Pacific Foundation</a>	<p>Established in 1958, the Georgia-Pacific Foundation sets aside resources to improve life in the communities where we operate. They have worked with thousands of outstanding community-based programs, service projects and disaster relief efforts, focusing their investment in four areas they believe make the most impact: education, environment, enrichment and entrepreneurship.</p>	<p>31-Oct-20</p>
<a href="#">Clean Water Loan Program</a>	<p>Iowa's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) is the best choice to finance publicly owned wastewater treatment, sewer rehabilitation, replacement, and construction, and storm water quality improvements. Since 1989, the CWSRF has provided more than \$1.4 billion in financing assistance for water pollution control.</p>	<p>Rolling</p>
<a href="#">Power of Connection Community Grant</a>	<p>The ITC/IRDC "Power of Connection" Community Grant Program will have three major objectives: Provide technical assistance and the potential for grant funding to rural communities seeking to build capacity, drive new projects, expand leadership opportunities and plan strategically; Make use of existing resources to provide a broad portfolio of services to communities, filling a current need for this comprehensive review; Enhance under the umbrella of IRDC the coordination and collaboration of the 100+ entities who are members of the Council.</p>	<p>Rolling</p>
